

## Basic Hat with Earflaps



### Materials:

Crochet Hook K (6.5mm)

Worsted (#4) weight yarn – amount depends on size you are making (50-120 yards)

Yarn Needle & Scissors

### Stitches Used:

Hdc = half double crochet

Sc = single crochet

Ch = chain

Slst = slip stitch

Join = this means to join the rounds together with a slip stitch

St = Stitch

### Gauge Check:

*Please check gauge for appropriate sizing, change hook to correct size to obtain gauge.*

*With Hook K: 9 rows with 12 hdc = 4 inches square*

### Hat Sizing (not including earflaps):

Newborn (12 ¼" around & 5" high - fits up to 14" circumference)

3 to 6 Months (14" around & 5 ½" high - fits up to 15" or 16" circumference)

6 to 12 Months (16" around & 6" high - fits up to 18" circumference)

12 to 24 Months (17" around & 6 ½" high - fits up to 19" circumference)

Child (18" around & 7 ½" high - fits up to 20" circumference)

Youth / Ladies (19" around & 8" high – fits up to 21" circumference)

Adult / Men's (20" around & 8 ½" high – fits up to 22" circumference)

**Basic Hat & Earflap Pattern:**

- ✓ Count the beginning chain of all half double crochet rows
- ✓ Do NOT count the beginning chain of single crochet rows

**Newborn size:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6-11: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (35) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 5 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 9 st, ch 2, turn (10 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R5: hdc2tog, hdc in next 1 st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 9 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 6 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

**3-6 Month size:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 12 sts, 2hdc in next st, hdc in next 12 sts, 2hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, join (38)

R7-12: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (38) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 5 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 9 st, ch 2, turn (10 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R5: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 10 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 8 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

**6-12 Month size:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join (42)

R7-13: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (42) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 4 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 11 st, chain 2, turn (12 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 7 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (10)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (10)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R5: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R6: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R7: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 11 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 7 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

**12 – 24 Month size:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join (42)

R7: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 13 st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 13 st) around, join (45)

R8-14: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (45) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 6 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 11 st, chain 2, turn (12 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 7 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (10)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (10)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R5: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R6: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R7: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 12 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 9 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

**Child size:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join (42)

R7: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 5 sts, (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts) around, join (49)

R8-16: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (49) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 6 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 13 st, chain 2, turn (14 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 9 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (12)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (12)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 7 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (10)

R5: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (10)

R6: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R7: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R8: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R9: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 12 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 9 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

**Youth / Ladies:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join (42)

R7: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 5 sts, (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts) around, join (49)

R8: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 16 sts, (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 15 sts) around, join (52)

R9–18: Ch 2, hdc in each st around, join (52) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 11 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 13 st, chain 2, turn (14 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 9 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (12)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (12)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 7 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (10)

R5: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (10)

R6: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R7: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R8: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R9: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 13 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 11 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

### **Adult / Men's:**

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch, join (7 st)

R2: Ch 2, 2hdc in each st around, join (14)

R3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st (2hdc in next st, hdc in next st) around, join (21)

R4: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts) around, join (28)

R5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 3 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts) around, join (35)

R6: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 4 sts (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts) around, join (42)

R7: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 5 sts, (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts) around, join (49)

R8: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next 6 sts, (2hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts) around, join (56)

R9–20: Ch 2, hdc in each stitch around, join (56) do not fasten off, if you want a **basic hat** ch 1 and work 1 row of sc's / for **earflaps** slst in next 13 stitches, you will begin making the earflaps at this point.

R1: Ch 2, hdc in next 13 st, chain 2, turn (14 st counting chain 2)

R2: hdc2tog, hdc in next 9 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (12)

R3: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (12)

R4: hdc2tog, hdc in next 7 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (10)

R5: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (10)

R6: hdc2tog, hdc in next 5 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (8)

R7: hdc in each st across, ch 2, turn (8)

R8: hdc2tog, hdc in next 3 st, hdc2tog, ch 2, turn (6)

R9: hdc2tog, hdc in next st, hdc2tog, (4)

\*If this is your first earflap fasten off and count across front of hat 14 st, join in next stitch and repeat earflap (in the back of the hat there will be 14 stitches between earflaps). If this is your second earflap do not fasten off, ch 1 (make sure right side of hat is facing you) and do one round of sc (along sides of earflap and around hat), join in the 1<sup>st</sup> sc and fasten off.

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**Ties:** You can make the ties on the earflap one color or 2 colors. If you already know how to make ties on earflaps do them however you are comfortable. I simple take 2 strands of yarn, measure about 9 feet long, fold them in half, at the fold, join with a slst to the center base of the earflap. I then take a large hook (size L or N) and complete 13-16 chains depending on the length you prefer, tie them off. At this point just trim up the tassels to have even ends.
